The Maltese archipelago lies at the centre of the Mediterranean, with Malta 93km south of Sicily .

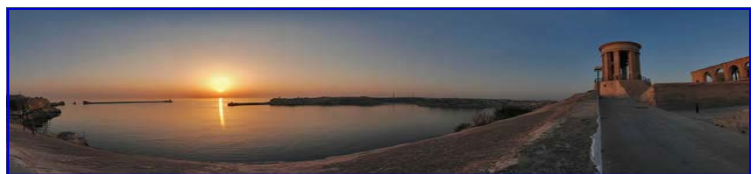
The archipelago consists of three islands: Malta, Gozo and Comino.
